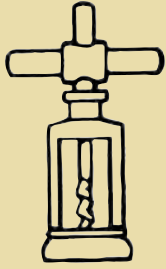
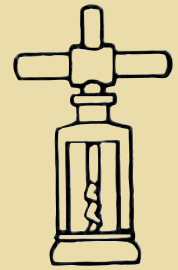

“The ethereal 2005 Cabernet Franc (about 200 cases produced) displays hints of roasted herbs, truffles, cranberries, black cherries, and even blacker fruits. Its mid-weight, elegance, and purity are sublime, but the wine packs plenty of intensity, behaving like a big red, without being heavy or ponderous. Drink this 2005 over the next 7-8 years.”

Cabernet Franc 58%, Cabernet Sauvignon 42%

A rare California offering, it possesses the elegance of a French Bordeaux combined with the power that is so easily obtainable in California. There is pinpoint precision, good sweet integration of wood, medium to full body, and a seamless, velvety-textured finish.
