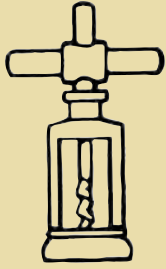
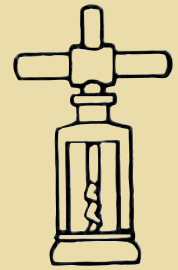

A magnificent texture, rich, sweet fruit, ripe tannin, well-integrated acidity, alcohol, and wood, and a long finish suggest this terrific effort can be drunk now and over the next 12-15 years.
