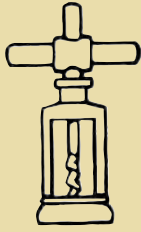
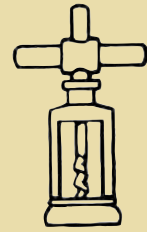

The 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon is nicely layered with silky, expressive red fruit, sweet herbs and licorice. The 2008 comes across as quite understated and refined. Unlike many 2008s, it will drink well right out of the gate. It is a classy, subtle Cabernet Sauvignon long on personality. Anticipated maturity: 2012-2018.

More seriously endowed, structured and tannic, but perhaps not as charming at present, the 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon Estate is a bigger, more muscular wine possessing outstanding depth, richness and potential.

However, it needs 3-4 years of cellaring and should keep for 15+. Drink: 2013 - 2028"
