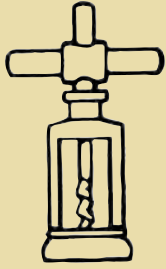
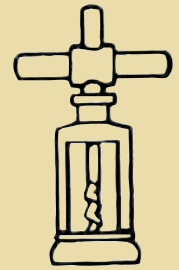

### 2005 PHAEDRUS

“The more supple 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Phaedrus is a blend of 86% Cabernet Sauvignon and the rest Malbec and Petit Verdot. Aged 16 months in one-half new French Oak, there are 719 cases of this beauty. A dense ruby/purple color is accompanied by loads of crème de cassis fruit intermingled with notions of roasted herbs, coffee beans, licorice, and a subtle touch of background oak. The noble sweetness of the tannins, luscious, velvety textured mid-palate, and long finish suggest this wine can be drunk now or cellared for 12-15+ years.” *719 cases. Review: Dec., 2008*

### 2003 PHAEDRUS

“The 2003 Cabernet Sauvignon Phaedrus is Wolf Family Vineyards' second label. Made by Karen Culler, there are 408 cases of this primarily Cabernet Sauvignon cuvee. It exhibits an elegant, Bordeaux-like personality, a dark ruby/purple color, and hints of scorched earth, smoke, black and red currants, and a hint of tobacco leaf.” *408 cases. Review: Dec., 2006*
